What is Apomorphine?

Parkinson's disease is a degenerative disease and with progression of the disease the beneficial effects of your oral medication become increasingly unpredictable.

Apomorphine is a medication for Parkinson disease patients in the advanced stage. The active ingredient is apomorphine hydrochloride. It is a strong and direct acting dopamine-receptor agonist.

Apomorphine offers improved disease management when oral medication is failing to control motor fluctuations. Given subcutaneously, it has a rapid onset of antiparkinsonian effect. Apomorphine is administered via a catheter over a small portable pump system.
